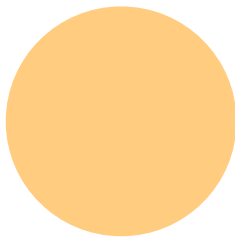
Elementary School Students (Grades 1-8):
