Registration Fee: \$100.

The Registration Fee is payable once only per child. For returning children, the Registration Fee will be applied to tuition.

Siblings: 30% discount given for a second sibling who attends at least twice weekly with the first sibling.

HST: Fees are exempt from HST.

Payment Options:

Early bird option: Receive 5% off!!

Pay for the year in full before Labour day.

Option 2: Provide upon registration three post dated cheques:
September 1 (4 months);
January 1 (3 months);
April 1 (3 months). Receive \$100 off.

Option 3: Provide upon registration ten monthly post dated cheques.

Please enquire if you need a different payment arrangement.

Please phone, fax, email, mail, or drop in with your registration and payment information: Your payment of the registration fee reserves a place for your child. Late registrants are welcome wherever a space is available. A parent or guardian may withdraw a child from the Little Readers program by giving the centre 30 days written notice of a child's last day in the program.

The centre will refund the full payment received for sessions scheduled after the child's last day in the program provided the child's last day in the program is not later than week 24 of the 37 week program.

The centre is unable to offer make-up classes or refunds in case of absence due to vacation, illness or other reasons.
