**BEGINNERS:** This level focuses on vocabulary. This course is designed to give students a strong foundation in the French

language. Students learn the basic pronunciation of French and become familiar with common greetings, numbers, days of the weeks, time and other every day vocabulary. Students will also learn to describe places, people and objects. Grammar covered includes masculine and feminine objects, words singular and plural, *avoir* and *etre*, negation, "er" verbs, articles, *il y a*, questions, possessive pronouns and demonstratives.

**INTERMEDIATE\*:** This level focuses on speaking. Themes include: the seasons and weather, food and beverages,

ordering food in a restaurant, asking for directions, vocabulary for home life, and hobbies. Grammar includes the -ir, -re and -cir verbs, comparatives, regular and irregular verbs, additional question types, le futur proche, le passe compose and the imperfect.

**ADVANCED\*:** This level focuses on vocabulary and conversation. Topics covered include: French culture, formal and polite

expressions, relationships, emotions, geography, professions and travel. The course begins with a review of grammar covered in the earlier levels, then goes on to cover more complex topics such as relative clauses, past tenses, conditionals, the subjunctive and the plus-que-parfait tenses. Student at this level are able to understand French music and radio broadcasts and speak with little difficulty.
